



Conversation Questions

1. How does Jesus's call to generosity challenge us to reframe our understanding of ourselves, from owners to stewards of God's resources (time, talents, money, relationships)? What practical steps can we take this week to live more fully as stewards?
2. How does the act of giving become an act of worship? How does it shape our view of God? What are some fears or hesitations that keep us from stepping out in radical generosity?
3. What does it look like to practically surrender "all" to God? (Consider examples beyond just finances - time, talents, possessions, ambitions). How does a "give it all away" mentality change our daily decisions and priorities?
4. How does our generosity (or lack thereof) impact not only our own lives but also our community (church, neighborhood, city)? How can we partner with God in bringing His blessing to others through our generosity?
5. What kind of legacy do you want to leave? What steps do you need to take to move in that direction? How can we cultivate a lifestyle of generosity that outlives us?
