1. How does the fear of looking like a “weirdo” or a fanatic stop you from moving past safe small talk with the people living right next door to me?
2. Looking at Acts 26:13-14, Paul traveled with companions who were completely blind to who Jesus really was. In what ways have we collectively normalized a similar “spiritual isolation” behind our garage doors and privacy fences today?
3. If you view your personal story less as a polished performance and more as a spiritual weapon, how does that change the way you look at your past mistakes or messy seasons?
4. Looking at Mark 5:19, why do you think Jesus prioritizes sending us back to our “own people” and our literal neighbors first rather than calling us to change the world somewhere far away?
5. Who is one specific neighbor or household on your block that you are committing to move from a mental picture into a real, prayer-covered relationship this week?
