



FAQ's

1. What is the total building cost?

The total cost is \$2,000,000, which will include funds raised by the Capital Campaign and a manageable mortgage.

2. Just how much will we need to borrow?

The amount we borrow will depend upon what God provides through His people. While we may need to borrow to complete the project, our response to the campaign is the deciding factor. The more we raise together, the less we need to borrow.

3. Is there a certain amount of money I am expected to commit?

No. After asking God for guidance, each person will decide their individual commitment. Our goal is not equal gifts, but equal sacrifice.

4. What is expected of my family in making a financial commitment?

Every family is being asked to pray about its commitment. No one will be pressured, and no commitments will be published. We believe that if we are obedient managers of what God provides, He will provide everything we need to effectively do His work.

5. Will God help me make a commitment that seems beyond my means?

Making an unrealistic commitment can be detrimental, but often, what seems out of reach is closer than it appears! Priorities may need to be rearranged to participate at a sacrificial level.





6. When and where will the commitments be made?

Most commitments will be made on Commitment Sunday, May 17th, during our services. However, leaders will give theirs on or before April 19th in one of the green offering boxes or handing it to Pastor Matt, Rob Wallace, or Brian Warrell.

7. How will commitments be received?

Your commitment will be placed in a sealed envelope and deposited in one of the green offering boxes or through our online form to ensure total confidentiality.

8. Do I have flexibility in making my commitment?

Yes. There are three general categories for giving:

1. Immediate gifts from accumulated cash.
2. Regular weekly or monthly gifts over the next three years.
3. Non-cash assets such as property, stocks, or bonds.

9. Can I divide my current giving between the General Budget and the Campaign?

We strongly encourage you to make your commitment "above & beyond" your regular giving. The missions and ministries we currently support still need to be funded; please do not transfer current giving to the Capital Campaign.

10. Will I have the opportunity to revise my commitment? Certainly. Since this is a commitment between you and the Lord, you may revise it at any time. We simply ask that changes be communicated in writing so leadership can update project projections.
